Music fans must catch **Kate Miller-Heidke with Band**, 90s pin-up **Rick Price**, and the one off performance of Mark Jones and Craig Christies' new Australian chamber musical **After the Beep**.

Due to popular demand, Belgium's Micheline Van Hautem and Frederik Caelen from **Mich en Scène** are performing an extra show of **Madame** on **Saturday 24 June** at 4pm.
